ROAD STATUS

The winter road is officially closed to traffic due to ongoing construction activities. We anticipate opening the road to light traffic (pick up trucks) on January 22 2010.

NEW WINTER ROAD TEAM

GILBERT ETHERINGTON

Gilbert Etherington is taking on a new role as the full time General Manager of Kimesskanemenow. This will involve a more administrative role than in past years when Gilbert was responsible for the operations side of Kimesskanemenow. Gilbert is a Certified Engineering Construction Technician, and worked for many years providing Technical Services to the Mushkegowuk communities.

WALLY TURNER

Wally Turner is also taking on a new role this year with the Winter Road. After joining the team last year as the Road Safety Coordinator, Wally has now been hired as the Operations Manager for the road. As such Wally will be responsible for all aspects of the winter road construction. Wally served the Mushkegowuk Communities for many years as Life Safety Officer and his expertise with respect to Health and Safety are welcome additions to Kimesskanemenow.

WINTER ROAD FOREMEN

This year, we have some returning Road Foremen, as well as new additions to the team. Gabriel Edwards, Edmund Edwards and Bernard Sutherland have all rejoined the Kimesskanemenow winter road team, and Jeff Innes and Bruce Nelson are the newbies.

Gabriel Edwards will be responsible for supervising the winter road construction and maintenance in the Attawapiskat section of the road. Gabby has worked on the winter road for the past several years and will be taking on a more intensive role as Kimesskanemenow acts as the General Contractor in this section of the road.

Edmund Edwards is also a familiar face on the winter road, and is back again this year to oversee road construction in the Kashechewan section of the road, from Kapiskau River to Albany Island. The Kashechewan First Nation will be acting as the General Contractor in this section of the road, with Derek Stephen overseeing things for Kashechewan.

Bernard Sutherland has worked on the road for the past several years, and is returning this year to oversee Road Construction in the Fort Albany Section of the road, from Albany Island to Halfway Creek. Kimesskanemenow is acting as the General Contractor in this section of the road, and Bernie will be the "go to" person.

As previously mentioned, Jeff Innes is our new guy on the road, and is a welcome addition to the team. In Section One of the road, (Halfway Creek to Moosonee), a joint venture of Moose Cree contractors will be building the road, with C. S. Enterprises representing the joint venture as the General Contractor. Jeff's job will be to oversee the winter road construction in Section One,

ensuring that the road is built to specifications.

Bruce is another newbie to the team, although he is certainly not new to community members. Bruce has been hired as the Road Safety Coordinator and will be responsible for the Safety, Health and

Environmental Plan that Kimesskanemenow has put in place. Bruce will also be overseeing the Emergency Response for the winter road. Formerly Bruce was the Manager for the Moosonee Airport, and has extensive experience in Health and Safety. Welcome aboard Bruce!
